You may need special instructions. Please let us know if you:

- Are taking Coumadin, Plavix or any other blood thinner
- Are Diabetic
- Had a Heart Attack or Stroke in the past six months
- Have an Artificial Heart Valve or Heart Defibrillator
- May be Pregnant

Prep Instructions - Please read line by line to ensure a successful preparation

On the day of your procedure – Date: _____

- Do not eat any solid food or drink any alcoholic beverages.
- You may have clear liquids until _____ AM/PM (5 hours prior to arrival time)

You may not have anything to drink, chew gum, or eat hard candy 5 hours prior to your arrival time.

- At _____ AM/PM (2 hours prior to arrival time) use one Fleet enema. Wait one hour and then use the second Fleet enema.

Important Information

- Take heart, blood pressure, seizure, thyroid, chronic pain or anti-anxiety medications with a small amount of water up to 2 hours before your procedure.
- Bring a licensed driver. You will not be allowed to drive home. You may *not* take a cab alone.
- After your procedure:
 - Restart all medications as prior to the procedure unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.
 - Resume your usual diet unless otherwise instructed by the doctor.

Clear Liquids Diet

- *Gatorade is preferred*
- Clear fruit juices, white grape juice and apple juice
- Kool-Aid or PowerAde
- Clear soup, broth or bouillon
- Water, tea or coffee without cream
- Hard candies
- Soda pop
- Jell-O or popsicles
- Nothing red or purple
- Nothing alcoholic
